ABOUT OUR CAMPUSES

Boca Raton Campus/Online Division

The Main Campus of Everglades University is located in Boca Raton, Florida, which is conveniently accessible for residents of both Palm Beach and Broward Counties. The Boca Raton Campus provides ample free parking and is easily reached by I-95, Tri-Rail, and public bus service. The University building encompasses over 37,000 square feet of air-conditioned and well-lit offices, classrooms, computer labs, a library and a student lounge. The Online Division of Everglades University is located on the second floor of the Boca Raton Main Campus.

Miami Campus

The Miami off-campus instructional site is located just off Florida's Turnpike and Kendall Drive on Mills Drive in a spacious 24,404 square-foot beautifully remodeled facility located at the Palms at Town and Country shopping district and restaurant center. The facility features student lounge areas with an outdoor patio eating area, library, administrative offices, computer lab and stadium seating classrooms with wireless technology. The Miami campus is conveniently accessible to the Miami International Airport and from both Broward County as well as Monroe County.

Orlando Campus

The Orlando Branch Campus of Everglades University is located in a spacious 28,000 square-foot building on Trafalgar Court, Maitland, Florida. The facility houses well-lit offices, classrooms, a computer lab, a library, faculty lounge and a student lounge. The campus is conveniently located close to I-4, the SunRail Station via Neighborlink shuttle service, Orlando International Airport, Altamonte Mall, and Florida Hospital. The Orlando Campus is a branch of the main campus in Boca Raton, Florida.



Sarasota Campus

The Sarasota Branch Campus of Everglades University is located in a spacious three-story building just off I-75 and University Parkway in Sarasota, Florida. The university occupies approximately 36,000 square feet of space. This includes well-lit offices, classrooms, two computer labs, two student lounges and a student career center. The Sarasota Campus shares a spacious library with a relaxing study area and a large auditorium with state-of-the-industry technology with Keiser University. The campus is surrounded by a beautiful landscape of 20 plus acres bordered by Lake Osprey. The Sarasota Campus is a branch of the main campus in Boca Raton, Florida.

Tampa Campus

Our Tampa off-campus instructional site is located right off the 275 interstate and just minutes from US Highway 589, Route 60, on Kennedy Boulevard across from West Shore Plaza and 2 miles south from International Mall. UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS

Alternative and Renewable Energy Management

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Alternative and Renewable Energy Management enables students to explore courses in Solar Energy and Photovoltaics; Energy and the Environment; Alternative Energy Safety; Nuclear Energy; Wind Energy; Geothermal Energy; Hydroelectric Energy; and Managing an Alternative Energy Project. Emphasis is placed on communication skills, global awareness, management skills, organizational behavior, critical thinking, codes and standards, and construction and environmental regulations and requirements. As our modern-day society seeks to be more responsible with our natural resources and less dependent on unsustainable sources of energy, the need for competent professionals with an Alternative and Renewable Energy Management Degree is on the rise.

Alternative Medicine

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Alternative Medicine enables students to explore the exciting field of Alternative Medicine with courses in: Herbology and Botany; Nutrition and Aging; Traditional Chinese Medicine; Homeopathy; and Antioxidants. This degree will enable the graduate to become a well-rounded and educated professional with a broad basis for decision making in the ever-changing field of healthcare. Courses are suited for practicing healthcare professionals such as Nurses, Massage Therapists, Spa Directors, and Medical Assistants who want to incorporate these natural healing arts into their careers. A concentration in **Science Studies** is ideal for students preparing for advanced education.



Aviation/Aerospace

The Bachelor of Science Degree with a major in Aviation/Aerospace combines a specific aviation/aerospace industry component with a general education foundation and can include an area of concentration.

Specific concentrations include: **Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS), Management, Airport Operations Management, Aviation Safety, Flight Operations, Aviation Maintenance Management and Aviation Security.**

The program provides the aviation professional with an extensive academic background to complement his/her aviation technical background whether it is in Air Traffic Control, Aviation Maintenance, Flight Operations, Dispatch Operations through verified FAA Certifications or Military Aviation Operations. The degree prepares graduates for entry into and advancement within the diverse field of aviation specific to their desires and industry needs. Graduates will be equipped to meet the challenges of the diverse and dynamic aviation industry.

Business Administration

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration gives students the opportunity to explore industry specific topics including International Business, Management Information Systems, Marketing Management and Research and Statistical Analysis among others. Students will learn how to think critically, make sound business decisions, and be active participants in the dynamic and ever-changing business world. Opportunities are provided to apply theories to real world problems in a supportive environment of small and personalized classes. Graduates will be qualified for managerial employment in their chosen discipline in both private and public sector organizations.

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS

Construction Management

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Construction Management focuses on the management skills and construction business knowledge required for the continually changing environment of the industry. With courses in Construction Contracts; Building Codes and Quality Control; Construction Scheduling; Construction Law; Building Construction Drawing; and Managing a Construction Project, this degree provides students with a solid education and training in business and management applications. The Construction Management Degree program prepares graduates for productive careers in the industry as Construction Managers, Project Managers, and more.

Crisis and Disaster Management

The major in Crisis and Disaster Management will prepare students for careers in public and private industries including local and state government, healthcare, and community services. Individuals with a Crisis and Disaster Management Degree are the very men and women who design and carry out plans to reduce the loss of life and property when disaster inevitably strikes.

Courses include, but are not limited to Emergency Preparedness and Response; Emergency Management and Public Policy; Human Resource Management; Basic Emergency Planning; and Disaster Health Management. Emphasis is placed on communication skills, global awareness, management skills, critical thinking, theory, planning, response, relief, recovery and specific cases associated with public emergencies, disasters, and catastrophes. Included in the curriculum are natural, technical, and human-induced crises.



Environmental Policy and Management

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Environmental Policy and Management provides instruction in management skills, environmental policy, and specific technical and occupational subjects, such as the Impact of Industrialization on the Environment, Regulation and Law, Climate Change and Environmental Technology and Management. Students will also have the opportunity to focus on several emerging fields of study including global environmental change, environmental planning, and environmental sustainability.

Hospitality Management

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Hospitality Management provides students with a comprehensive curriculum of hospitality management entities from a financial, economics, marketing and management perspective combined with a solid general education foundation. Graduates will understand a variety of the hospitality management principles that include analytical, technical, and critical thinking skills to solve problems in an ethical manner and communicate effectively in today's business environment.

Topics covered include Convention and Exhibition Management, Front of the House, and Business and Technology of Sustainability. This program of study will prepare graduates for managerial employment positions such as Managers, Assistant Managers, Supervisors, and other related administrative assignments in the field.

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS



International Business

The Bachelor of Science Degree with a major in International Business offers instruction in business management skills. Students can examine courses in Management Information Systems; Global Strategy and Policy; Politics in International Business; Marketing Management; Negotiation Communications and much more. This program of study will prepare graduates for managerial employment positions such as Managers, Assistant Managers, Supervisors, and other related administrative assignments in the business environment, globally.

Land and Energy Management

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Land and Energy Management delivers instruction in management skills, land and energy specific technical and occupational subjects, such as Land Use Planning Regulations; Oil, Gas and Energy Geopolitics and Law; Communication and Environmental Justice; and Geographic Information System Data Analysis and Mapping (GIS). Students will obtain a broad based knowledge of the negotiations in the landwork and energy industries combined with a general education foundation and business and management applications. Emphasis is placed on communication skills, global awareness, management skills, critical thinking, law and policy, and environmental regulations and requirements.

Marine Resources Management

The Bachelor of Science Degree with a major in Marine Resources Management provides instruction in environmental sciences that is designed to allow students to apply specific knowledge of marine, coastal and wetlands areas to the business of managing natural resources. Emphasis is placed on the policies that govern the management of resources in marine, coastal and wetlands environments, as well as human interactions with those ecologies. The program

explores the intersection of business, environmental science, and environmental policy, with a focus on ethical and sustainable decision-making in regards to marine, coastal and wetlands resources. The program augments the environmental science background with additional education in communication, business, management, critical thinking, sustainability, regulations, and policies.

This degree includes courses in Marine Biology, Environmental Science, Coastal Wetlands Management, Environmental Policy and Management, Environmental Impact Analysis, Marine Policy and Management, and Marine Resources Sustainability. The degree is designed to prepare graduates for professions focused on marine resources, working with government entities, non-profit organizations, or private industry related to the management, development, or sustainability of coastal or wetland environments or ecologies.

Surveying Management (for Construction and Roadway)

The Bachelor of Science Degree with a major in Surveying Management delivers instruction in management skills and surveying for construction, industry specific technical and occupational subjects, such as Surveying for Route and Boundary, Platting, and Geotechnical Technology. Students will obtain a solid general education and extensive training in business and management applications as well as law, regulations, planning, design, theory and methods used in the surveying field. Graduates of this program will be prepared for productive management careers in surveying for construction and roadway.

GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS

Aviation Science

The Master's Degree in Aviation Science offers aviation professionals the opportunity to significantly enhance their knowledge of the aviation community and aerospace industry.

This program delivers a rigorous, broad-based curriculum for students to gain a mastery of the aviation field. Students will complete technical aviation coursework that will include Analysis of Transportation Systems, Airport Operations, Aerospace Communications Systems, Aerospace Logistics, Aircraft Simulation, Advanced Crew Resource Management Procedures, Aerospace Systems Safety, Advanced Security, and Safety Program Management. An Aviation Graduate Capstone Course will culminate the program, allowing students to demonstrate their mastery of program topics prior to advancing their careers. Concentrations are available including: **Aviation Security, Aviation Operations Management** and **Business Administration**.

Business Administration

The Master's Degree program in Business Administration emphasizes sound general principles and decision-making techniques that provide a base for continued learning and professional development in today's dynamic and ever-changing business world.

Students pursuing a Master's Degree in Business Administration from Everglades University will take courses in Accounting for Decision Makers; Strategic Sales and Marketing Management; Advanced Organizational Behavior; and Business Policy and Decision Making among others. Concentrations are available including: **Accounting for Managers, Aviation Management, Construction Management, Human Resource Management** and **Project Management**. A Graduate Business Capstone Course is also required as a culmination of this intensive program, allowing prospective graduates to demonstrate their newly acquired skills and expertise in the field of business administration prior to embarking on their careers.



Construction Management

The Master's Degree in Construction Management allows students seeking upper-level management positions in various sectors of the construction industry to improve their competency in project, program and company management areas. The program is designed to provide students with the opportunity to apply advanced theoretical concepts and knowledge from all functional areas of the construction business through an analytical, decision-making process which focuses on solving practical problems.

The Master's in Construction Management curriculum provides a challenging and creative learning environment, including courses such as Strategic Management of Construction Organizations, Advanced Construction Estimating, Construction Claims, Construction Cost Analysis and Financial Control, Construction Productivity, and Legal Aspects in Construction.

The Master's Degree in Construction Management seeks to provide students with a well-rounded view of the purpose, operation, and management of construction business entities. Graduates will be able to understand how analytical tools apply to business policy and decision-making as well as be able to understand management theory and organizational behavior. Graduates with a Master's Degree in Construction Management will attain strengthened skills in the business and management of construction organizations, as well as to provide the tools to understand how economic and financial events impact business decision making, and apply them to the construction industry.



GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAMS

Entrepreneurship

Students will explore basic business fundamentals as well as current industry trends while taking courses such as Leadership Skills for Managers; Strategic Sales and Marketing Management; Entrepreneurial Innovation and Technology; and Global Business Ventures among related classes. An Entrepreneurship Capstone Course will culminate the program, enabling students to demonstrate the knowledge and expertise gained throughout their coursework.
